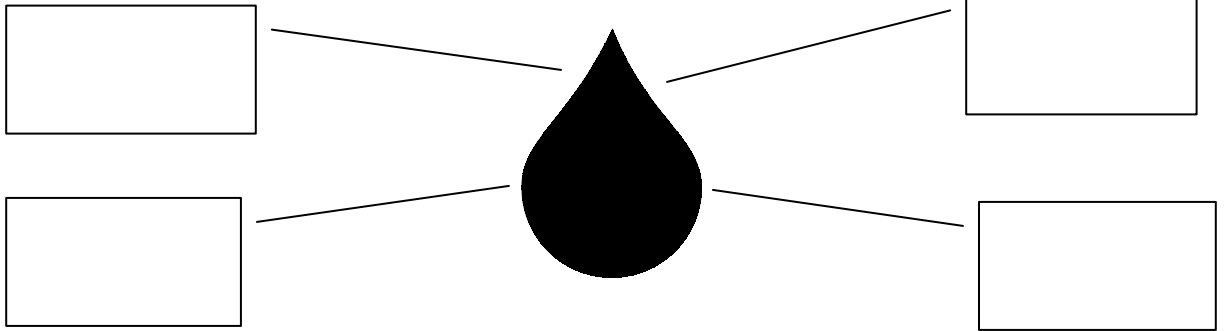

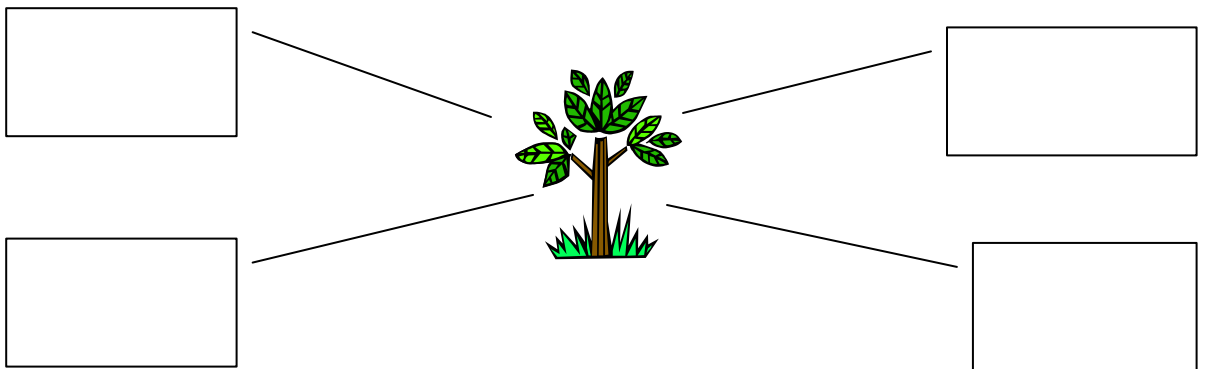

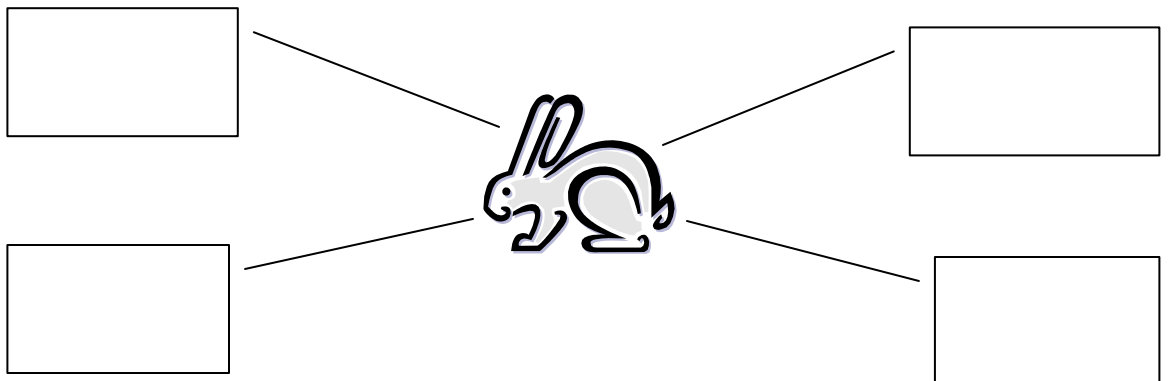

Acorn Survey

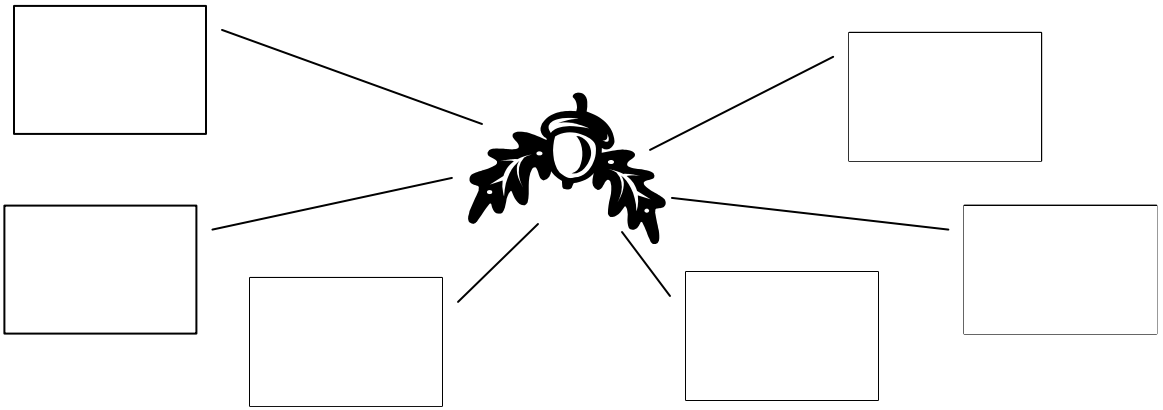
Randomly place 4 or 5 hula hoops on the ground under an oak tree. Count the number of acorns inside the hula-hoops. Record your data below.
