Lolly Baby switched production of the nursing bottles and pacifiers from polycarbonate (PC) to Eastman Tritan™ copolyester. Tritan offers superior clarity after repeated exposure to high heat and chemical dishwashing detergents, while products made with polypropylene and PC can haze or whiten in similar conditions. Additional benefits of the material transition include a 2 to 3 percent reduction in product weight due to the lower density of Tritan compared with PC, resulting in less material consumption and increased sustainability.
