

The Alabama Department of Environmental Management (ADEM) has completed its review of the Corrective Measures Study (CMS) for the Choccolocco Creek Wastewater Treatment Plant Spoil Pile dated February 27, 2002. The Department concurs with Solutia's recommendation that Alternative 3 can effectively minimize long term exposure risks and eliminate the downstream transport of PCBs from the stockpiles. The Department has determined that Alternative 3 is an appropriate corrective measure for addressing the management of the PCB contaminated stockpiled soils at this site. Therefore, a Corrective Measures Work Plan detailing the corrective action outlined in the CMS should be prepared and submitted to the Department within 45 days of receipt of this letter.
