

2023 Spring Team Golf League Rules

(Updated March 29, 2023)

- Must be an Eastman Golf Club member in order to be eligible
- Maximum of 7 players on the roster
- Can add to roster through regular league play (they must sign the roster before playing)
- Player must have played two times in order to be eligible for post season play
- Can't play on more than one team
- Can't pick someone up at the course that is not eligible
- A team can play with as little as two players (one for each match; no additional strokes given)
- USGA Golf Rules apply unless covered below:
- Improve your lie up to one club length anywhere on the course, no closer to the hole except the green. Do not change conditions (example: can't move from rough to fairway).
- In order to keep play moving, play LOST BALLS and OUT OF PLAY as a lateral hazard. Drop where you think the ball went out or was lost and add one stroke.
- Double Par maximum score on a hole
- Any questionable rulings need to be agreed to by the foursome. (i.e. Condition of bunkers)

This league is a match play league (teams will be paired against one another playing to win each hole; the team that wins the most holes wins the match). The matches will consist of 9 holes.

Playing for three possible wins:

- 1 win for Select Shot Match
- 1 win for Best Ball Match
- 1 win for most holes won for both matches combined

If there is a tie, teams will split the point(s); there will be no playoff holes in the regular season.

The lead group in each match is the Select Shot Match; the second will be Best Ball

Tees:

- Women play the Red Tees
- Men play the White Tees
- Senior Men (62 -74) play the Gold Tees
- Super Senior Men (75 - over) play the Red Tees
- Youth (11 thru 14) play the Gold Tees
- Youth (10 and under) play the Red Tees

There will be **closest to the pin** contest on the par threes.

Make sure that the scorecards are marked correctly and turn them into the ERC Coordinator or the Pro Shop.
