- **Drive** a zero-incident mindset to protect our employees, neighbors and the environment in the communities in which we operate, by understanding the health and environmental impact of our raw materials and products where they are manufactured or used.
- **Build** a strong culture of responsible global trade that sustains our efforts to eliminate illicit diversion, identify unlawful transactions, and comply with treaties, trade agreements and legal sanctions.
